The Central European Tectonic Group is an open scientific association that brings together geoscientists with the interest in geodynamic processes of the Earth's crust in a broad measure.

The mission of the Central European Tectonic Group (CETEG) is to strengthen the professional communication and the coordination of activities of formal groups and individuals from the Central European countries interested in broadly scoped tectonics and geodynamics of the Earth crust.

20th CETEG Meeting – CETEG2024

The Meeting will take place in the Sudety Mountains (Sudetes), in the village of Srebrna Góra near the town of Ząbkowice Śląskie, ca. 65 km S of Wrocław. The meeting will be held at one of the most interesting locations in the Sudetes, on the Sudetic Boundary Fault, and at the junction between the Góry Sowie (Owl Mountains) Metamorphic Massif and the remains of a syntectonic intramontane Bardo Basin. Emphasizing the jubilee nature of this meeting, our focus during the field sessions will be on the Variscan orogenic belt, encompassing both its orogenic and post-orogenic evolution. Additionally, both oral and poster sessions will present diverse topics spanning the well-established subjects of the annual meetings:

- orogenic belts and basins evolution
- relationship between magmatism, metamorphism and tectonics
- structural geology
- salt tectonics

- low temperature thermochronology
- post-Variscan tectonics
- neotectonics and present-day geodynamics
- geohazards
- other topics

In proposing the above topics, we remain open to issues beyond them. If there are issues you would like to address in a separate session, please let us know.

Overview of the programme

- 24th April: Pre-conference field session: From Neoproterozic sedimentation on the peri-Gondwanan extended shelf to the Variscan collision of terranes. The history preserved in the Kamieniec Metamorphic Belt and the Doboszowice Metamorphic Complex
- 25th and 26th of April: In-house topical sessions, oral and poster presentations
- 26th of April: Gala dinner and awards ceremony
- 27th of April: Post-conference field trip: Late- to post-Variscan structural evolution of tectonic grabens on top of the Góry Sowie Massif
